Judge Morin graduated from University of Rhode Island in 1967 and from Catholic University of America's Law School in 1970. He was admitted to practice in Rhode Island in 1970, the United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island 1970; the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit 1970; and the United States Court of Military Appeals 1970. Prior to his appointment to the Bench, Judge Morin had a general law practice. He was also defense counsel and a legal assistance officer for the Judge Advocate General Corps of the US Naval Reserve, located in the first naval district, Boston, Massachusetts. He also served as an instructor on the staff of the United States Naval Justice School in Newport in 1973 and 1974. Additionally, he served as Assistant Town Solicitor in West Warwick, Rhode Island from 1984 to 1987. Judge Morin was a member of the Rhode Island State Senate 1974-1976 and 1980-1983. He was appointed to the Bench in 1991 by Governor Sundlun and was sworn in on October 31, 1991. He currently serves as a member of the Rhode Island Commission on Judicial Tenure and Discipline, The Supreme Court's Law Day Committee, a member of the Workers' Compensation Bench/Bar Committee, a delegate to the Rhode Island Trial Judges Association, member of the Rhode Island Bar Association and served on the Board of Trustees for the Kent County Memorial Hospital for 15 years.
