Judge Ricci graduated from the University of New England's St. Francis College in 1966. He graduated Western New England School of Law in 1974. He was admitted to practice in the State of Rhode Island in 1975. In the eight years prior to his appointment to the Bench, Judge Ricci had a general neighborhood practice. He was also legal counsel to the Rhode Island Department of Labor and Training's Workers' Compensation Unit from 1998 until his appointment to the Bench in 2003. Additionally, he was Assistant Town Solicitor for the town of North Providence from 1996 to 2003. He also served as legal counsel to the Rhode Island Consumers' Council. He was appointed to the Bench by Governor Carcieri in 2003 and sworn in on May 9, 2003. Judge Ricci is on the Board of Directors of the St. Thomas Moore Society and has been a religious education instructor at St. Anthony's Church. In 1998 he was awarded the Rhode Island Bar Association's Dorothy Lohman Community Service Award.
