Judge Ferrieri graduated Providence College in 1982 and Suffolk Law School in 1985. He was admitted to practice in Rhode Island in 1985; the United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island in 1986. Prior to his appointment to the Bench, Judge Ferrieri was engaged in a general law practice focusing on workers' compensation, civil litigation, personal injury law, and real estate. He was a member of the Rhode Island Association for Justice, the Rhode Island Bar Association, the Justinian Law Society, and the Workers' Compensation Bench Bar Committee. He was a frequent lecturer for the Rhode Island Bar Association C.L.E. programs focusing on workers' compensation practice as well as a lecturer for the Rhode Island Department of Labor and the International Workers' Compensation Foundation. He successfully completed the general jurisdiction course for the National Judicial College in October of 2008.

Judge Ferrieri was appointed to the Workers' Compensation Court by Governor Carcieri in 2008 and was sworn in on October 7, 2008. He is a member of the Rhode Island Trial Judges Association and serves on various committees for the Workers' Compensation Court.
