ADMINISTRATIVE NONSTANDARD TEST ACCOMMODATIONS

The policy of the Rhode Island Board of Bar Examiners is to provide reasonable administrative nonstandard testing accommodations to applicants who are in need of such accommodations and who are otherwise eligible to take the bar examination, but who do not qualify for accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), as amended. Applicants seeking nonstandard test accommodation must submit Form 8: Applicant Request for Administrative Nonstandard Test Accommodations.
