

DIGEST OF ETHICS ADVISORY PANEL
Opinion #92-6, Request #212
Issued January 14, 1992

An attorney seeks Panel advice as to whether or not it is proper to include the name of a "paralegal" on the firm's letterhead.

The Panel takes the position that the firm should follow Provisional Order No. 18 - Use of Legal Assistants Guideline 7, which states that the words "legal assistant" should be used rather than "paralegal" and the legal assistant non-lawyer status is clearly indicated. Also, the Panel believes that the names of the attorneys should be separated from the name of the legal assistant.
