ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2007-02

RE: Appeals from Kent County District Court

- a) **CIVIL:** All appeals from the District Court shall be heard by the Superior Court sitting in Kent County unless otherwise transferred by order of the Presiding Justice pursuant to § 8-2-27(b) of the General Laws (1997 Reenactment).

- b) **CRIMINAL:** Consistent with § 12-17-1 of the General Laws (2003 Reenactment) any appeal from a conviction or sentence imposed in the District Court sitting in Kent County or a request for a trial by jury in the first instance pursuant to Rule 9 of the District Court Rules of Criminal Procedure for an offense alleged to have been committed in Providence County (ex. Cranston, Johnston, Foster and Scituate), the clerk of the Kent County Superior Court shall forthwith transfer said matter to the Providence County Superior Court for trial.
