ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 96-18

RE: OBLIGEE OF BONDS POSTED BY CONSTABLES  
Pursuant to R.I.G.L. 45-16-4.4(d)

In consideration of the passage of Public Law 96-138, effective August 2, 1996, abolishing the position of Chief Supervisory Clerk of the Superior Court, as it applies to the provisions of R.I.G.L. 45-16-4-4(d) relating to bonds to be posted by constables authorized by the Presiding Justice to serve process, I hereby issue the following order pursuant to 8-15-6 of the Rhode Island General Laws:

Any bond posted by a constable pursuant to subparagraph (d) of R.I.G.L. 45-16-4.4 shall be posted with the General Chief Clerk of the Superior Court and the obligee of any such bonds shall be said General Chief Clerk.
