Administrative Order 2001-01

RE: SUPERVISED VISITATION

The purpose of the Rhode Island Family Court Supervised Visitation Program is to provide parents the opportunity to visit with their children under the supervision of a court-trained facilitator. The primary concern of the staff facilitator shall be the best interests of the child or children during said visit(s).

Supervised visitation may be ordered to take place in the courthouse or off site. In the event that a facilitator has a reasonable belief that he or she and/or the child or children may be placed in jeopardy, the facilitator has the discretion to immediately terminate such visitation. A party aggrieved by any termination of supervised visitation may file an appropriate motion with the court.
