ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2007-01

RE: PARENTING TIME MISSED VISIT POLICY

The purpose of the Rhode Island Family Court Supervised Visitation Program is to provide parents the opportunity to visit with their child(ren) under the supervision of a court-trained facilitator.

In the event that a parent scheduled to visit has missed two (2) or more visits without justification, the supervised visitation shall be terminated until further order of the court. Any parent aggrieved by a decision to terminate visitations must petition the Chief Judge or his designee for re-instatement.
