

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #79-7

The following scheduling procedures pertaining to juvenile calendars will become effective on a statewide basis with the commencement of the Fall calendar.

- 1) The juvenile calendar will be called at 9:30 a.m. At the call of the calendar, attorneys or parties of interest will indicate whether their case is ready formal, ready short or ready long. Formal and short matters will be heard first. The court may issue sanctions against those parties not in attendance at the call of the calendar.
2. To assist the court with the expeditious hearing of juvenile cases, attorneys are urged to prepare consent decrees when the status quo of their case is to be maintained. Such matters will be called ready formal, therefore receiving priority on the calendar.
3. Cases involving voluntary termination of rights, adoptions and arraignments pertaining to ex parte detention orders will be scheduled for 2:00 p.m.
