ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 85-6

JUSTICES OF THE PEACE

In accordance with § 8-10-14.1 of the General Laws the Chief Judge of the Family Court is empowered to appoint Justices of the Peace who shall be authorized to set and take bail in all complaints bailable before the Family Court. If defendants are unable to post bail, said Justices may commit such defendants to the Adult Correctional Institution or release the defendant on personal recognizance. The Justice of the Peace will schedule an arraignment of said defendants before a Family Court Judge on the next hearing date of the Family Court at the J. Joseph Garrahy Judicial Complex, One Dorrance Plaza, Providence, Rhode Island. The prosecuting police department will be responsible for bringing the complaint, arrest warrant and all ancillary paperwork to the Domestic Relations Clerks' Office of the Family Court in Providence by 9:30 a.m. of the arraignment date.
