ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 86-1

RELEASE OF INFORMATION TO ARMED SERVICES

Whenever a person applies for enlistment in the armed services, that person must indicate whether he/she has a juvenile and/or adult record. If the person indicates that he/she has a juvenile record, that person signs a release form before a notary public, and the recruiter from the armed services mails the release or hand carries said release to the Juvenile Clerks' Office. Upon receipt of this form, the Juvenile Clerks' Office will be responsible for pulling the juvenile's folder and directing same along with the release form to the attention of a Family Court Judge who will review the folder and make a determination as to what information is to be released to the armed services.
