ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 93-2

RE: PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 13 - DIVORCE OR SEPARATION PROCEEDINGS - SUPPORT FOR
CHILDREN RECEIVING PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

In all divorce cases where there are children receiving public assistance, (AFDC), the State of Rhode Island is a party in interest in all matters concerning child support (AFDC).

Notice of a hearing must be sent to the Bureau of Family Support, (BFS), Legal Department, by the attorney commencing an action when child support is in question.
