ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 97-3

RE: ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER PAYMENT OF CHILD
SUPPORT INCOME WITHHOLDING ORDERS

Effective May 6, 1997, the Department of Administration, Division of Taxation - Child Support Enforcement has instituted a voluntary electronic funds transfer system (EFT System) for employers and withholding agents subject to an Income Withholding Order (DR-29). The EFT System is designed to be an alternative method of payment to the manual paper check method of payment of child support income withholding. As such, from May 6, 1997, henceforth, any employer or withholding agent who is required to withhold from an obligor's income sums sufficient to pay court-ordered child support pursuant to an Income Withholding Order (DR-29), may satisfy said obligation to withhold income by participation in the EFT System administered by the Division of Taxation - Child Support Enforcement.
