

- ◆ Drug and/or alcohol testing through the Rhode Island Family Court is only performed with a **COURT ORDER**.
- ◆ All screening calls are **RANDOM**.
- ◆ Calls are made Monday through Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. daily.
- ◆ You ***MUST*** come for your screening on the **DAY** you are called. There is no twenty-four (24) hour notice unless court ordered.
- ◆ You will not be screened if you come in any other day, unless permitted by the court.
- ◆ Screening hours are as follows: Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. ***NO SCREENS ARE PERFORMED BETWEEN 1:00 P.M. 1:30 P.M.***
- ◆ In order to expedite the drug screening process, please be prepared to provide a sample.
- ◆ We do not offer drug or alcohol treatment.
- ◆ You are responsible to provide this office with any updated contact information.
- ◆ Cell phone use is not permitted while in the Family Services Unit.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question: “I was called to come in, but I can’t. Can I come in tomorrow?”

Answer: Screens are **court ordered**. The only way you can change the day you are required to come in for your test is with a **court order**.

Question: “Can you send my screening results to my attorney?”

Answer: Results **cannot** be released to any party or attorney without a valid court order.

Question: “Your screening hours do not work for my schedule, what do I do?”

Answer: In order to change the venue of your screenings, you will need to consult with your attorney to have the court order changed.
