Non-Emergency/Non-Essential Matters - The following matters may be conducted during the period April 20, 2020 through May 15, 2020. No in-person hearing, however, shall take place until further notice. Unless a matter is defined by the Supreme Court as “emergency/essential” or the Presiding Justice has explicitly approved otherwise, all such matters must be handled remotely:

- COVID-19 Receivership Program Matters
- Receivership Proceedings
- Dispositive Motions (remote hearings only or where arguments not required)
- Post-Conviction Relief (remote conferences only, unless hearing on the merits can be done in the absence of an incarcerated petitioner)
- Administrative Appeals
- Magistrate Appeals

- Pre-Trial Motions
- Pre-Trial Conferences/Control Conferences/Status Conferences
- Other criminal or civil matters explicitly approved in advance by the Presiding Justice

Judicial Officers are encouraged to conference their cases via teleconferencing. Scheduling of teleconference phone lines shall be managed by the Office of Court Secretaries. Matters that require a hearing shall be conducted via the use of WebEx video-conferencing provided they are scheduled in advance with trained court personnel, that all participants have access to WebEx and that dial-up audio access is available to the public. Information on WebEx training and the guidelines for scheduling remote hearings will be forthcoming.
