### ORDER

Pursuant to Article IV, Rule 3.1(c)(2) of the Supreme Court Rules, the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Commission (the commission) has forwarded to this Court for approval proposed amendments to Rules 4.12 and 6.12 of the commission's rules and a proposed new commission Rule 2.12. A copy of the commission's proposal is attached to this Order. Upon our review of the proposed changes, we conclude that prior to our deciding whether to approve them, the members of the Bar should be provided an opportunity to offer comment thereon. Accordingly, we hereby direct that the following Order shall enter:

The proposed amendments to Rules 4.12 and 6.12 and proposed new Rule 2.12 are assigned for hearing to ***Wednesday, June 11, 2008, at 9:00 a. m.*** Any person interested in offering comment may do so at that time. Notice of intent to present oral comment should be submitted to the Clerk of the Supreme Court on or before ***Monday, June 9, 2008***, and parties desiring to submit written comment only may do so on or before said date.
