## ORDER

**Section 1.** Rule 16, subdivision (f), of the Rules of Appellate Procedure, entitled *Form of Briefs*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(f) Form of Briefs. All briefs filed pursuant to this rule shall be in the form set forth in Rule 18(b). If briefs are typewritten, they shall be on good paper of sufficient opacity to be distinctly legible. Briefs shall be bound on the left side and not at the top. Unless authorized by order of the Court, pursuant to a party's written motion, briefs shall not exceed a total of fifty (50) pages, except that reply briefs shall not exceed twenty-five (25) pages. Briefs exceeding these page limitations shall not be filed, either provisionally or otherwise, along with the motion seeking their approval, and no such brief will be accepted by the clerk until such motion has first been granted. The motion for leave to file a brief exceeding this subdivision's page limitations shall be accompanied only by a memorandum substantiating, to the Court's satisfaction, the need for the additional pages requested.
