EXECUTIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court under R.I.G.L. 1956 (1997 Reenactment) § 8-15-1, 8-15-2, and 8-15-4, it is hereby ordered as follows.

That the State Court Administrator hereby is authorized to enter into labor contracts and related labor agreements, including letters of understanding which shall be binding on all appointing authorities and personnel of the courts which are covered by [said] labor contracts and related agreements.

This authority is being exercised in order to ensure a uniform application of collective bargaining agreements relating to the state judicial system and to effectuate an orderly and consistent administration of a unified judicial system.
