In the Matter of John M. Cicilline.

ORDER

The respondent is a member of the bar of this state. On June 6, 2008 he entered a guilty plea to four felony counts charged in an Indictment filed in the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts. The indictment charged the respondent with one count of conspiracy in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 371; one count of obstruction of justice, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1503(a); and two counts of making false statements, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1001. On September 19, 2008 the respondent was sentenced to a term of imprisonment of eighteen months, commencing October 21, 2008.

The respondent has notified this court that he freely and voluntarily consents to his disbarment from the practice of law, and we are satisfied that he is fully aware of the implications of submitting his consent to disbarment. Accordingly, it is hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the respondent, John M. Cicilline, be and he is hereby disbarred on consent from engaging in the practice of law in this state. The effective date of this order is September 19, 2008.
