Permanent Advisory Committee on Women : and Minorities in the Courts :

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The composition of the Permanent Advisory Committee on Women and Minorities in the Courts established pursuant to Executive Order No. 2003-0001 (January 2, 2003), and the requirement regarding submission of reports to the Chief Justice are hereby changed as follows:

The Permanent Advisory Committee on Women and Minorities in the Courts shall have thirty-four (34) members: nine (9) of whom shall be judges/magistrates representing the various courts in the unified judicial system; one (1) of whom shall be a representative of the Department of Attorney General; one (1) of whom shall be a representative of the Office of the Public Defender; one (1) one of whom shall be a representative of Rhode Island Legal Services, Inc.; eight (8) of whom shall be non-judicial employees representing the various courts; five (5) of whom shall be active members of the Bar of this state; and nine (9) of whom shall be members of the general public who shall be broadly representative of all segments of the community.

The committee shall submit reports to the Chief Justice, which reports shall include a summary of the committee's activities along with recommendations for improving the administration of justice as initiatives are identified.
