

In re Amendment to Provisional Rule A, :
Mediation Session Procedures :
(Transmission of the Record) :

ORDER

Subdivision A(5) of Provisional Rule A (as amended), which provisional rule is situated in the Appendix to the Rules of Appellate Procedure and is captioned “Mediation Session Procedures,” is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Provisional Rule A

Mediation Session Procedures

* * *

“A(5). Ordering of Transcript, Transmission of the Record, and Filing of Briefs. In order to expedite the mediation process and spare the parties as much initial expense as possible, the ordering of the transcript in respect to cases eligible for and referred to mediation, shall be extended to a date sixty (60) days from the filing of the notice of appeal, and the time for transmittal of the record of the trial court to the Supreme Court shall be extended to a date sixty (60) days from the date of the ordering of the transcript. This extension may be modified by special order issued by the mediator-justice or any other justice of the Supreme Court. After the mediation session, the mediator-justice may make such order as may be appropriate in respect to the ordering of the transcript and the filing of briefs or memoranda in the event that the case is not settled.
