EXECUTIVE ORDER

COVID-19 Pandemic Response – Payment of Indigent Defense Services

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by G.L. (1997 Reenactment) § 8-15-2 and in

response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the extraordinary circumstances that have arisen as a

result, Executive Order 13-07 is hereby amended as follows:

Court appointed attorneys shall be permitted to request partial payments

under Section E, Request for Payment, for services rendered to date in an amount

not to exceed fifty percent (50%) of the threshold amount on the case(s) for which

payment is sought. The Office of Finance and Budget shall provide a procedure

for payment to the court appointed attorneys which will be available on the home

page of the Payment for Indigent Defense Services Portal.

The foregoing measures shall remain in place through May 17, 2020 or until

such time that a new Executive Order is issued revoking or amending this Order.
