

NO CONTACT ORDERS

- In all domestic violence offenses, a No Contact Order (an order of protection) is issued automatically by the Judge and/or the Justice of the Peace.
- If you are the victim or complaining witness and wish to drop the No Contact Order, you must speak to a Domestic Violence advocate in order to appear before a Judge to drop the order.
- You may contact the District Court Clerk's Office to receive contact information for the advocate.
