## ORDER

Article IV, Rule 3 of the Supreme Court Rules for Periodic Registration of Attorneys and of the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Regulations are hereby amended as follows:

## Rule 3.2. MCLE requirements.

(b) Section 3.2(a) of this rule shall not apply to the following attorneys who may be subject to certification of the exemption or waiver:

(4) Attorneys holding a full-time federal, state, or municipal position office and who are not engaged in the practice of law shall be exempt during their term(s) of employment office;

## **RULE 1.3.2. MCLE REQUIREMENTS.**

(b) *Exemptions*. Article IV, Rule 3.2(a) and subsection (a) shall not apply to the following Active Practitioners who may be subject to certification of the exemption or waiver:

(4) Attorneys holding a full-time federal, state, or municipal position office and who are not engaged in the practice of law shall be exempt during their term(s) of employment office but must certify said status submit an attestation that the attorney is not engaged in the practice of law on office letterhead indicating job title

and any other relevant documentation to the MCLE Commission on the summary
reporting form (Appendix G via the MCLE Portal) by June 30 of each MCLE
Reporting Year;
