RE: Release of Bar Examination Results

Results of the February 2026 Rhode Island Bar Examination are scheduled to be released on **Friday, April 24, 2026**.

- A list of passing applicants **and** the formal, group swearing-in ceremony schedule will be posted on the Judiciary's website (<https://www.courts.ri.gov/News/Pages/News.aspx>) under the "News" link after 1:30 pm on Friday, April 24, 2026.
- Official results letters are mailed via U.S. mail the afternoon of results day to the street address previously provided by applicants in their application. **Only the official results letter includes specific scoring information.** Official results letter will include the written scaled score, MBE scaled score, and total Uniform Bar Examination score.
- Rhode Island Supreme Court Attorney Portal (RISCAP) dashboard status will be switched from pending to either pass or fail as appropriate. This typically takes a few days to implement.

In-person, formal group swearing-in ceremonies will be held during the week of May 4, 2026 in the Supreme Court courtroom located on the 7th floor of the Licht Judicial Complex, 250 Benefit Street, Providence, RI 02903.

- The dates and time assigned to applicants are firm.

- Applicants are asked to report to the Supreme Court Clerk's Office 15 minutes prior to their assigned swearing-in time to sign-in and obtain further instruction.
- Swearing-in ceremonies are open to the public and seating is on a first-come first-served basis.

Successful applicants will not be sworn-in if their Petition is incomplete.

Applicants will be notified in their official results letter if their Petition is incomplete and that their ability to participate in the swearing-in ceremonies is on hold.

Unsuccessful applicants will receive instructions on how to reapply for admission along with a deadline by which they must reapply in their official results letter.

Reminder: The bar application is continuing in nature and must be kept up-to-date until the applicant is sworn-in and registered with the Rhode Island Supreme Court. Amendments to Petitions must be submitted via RISCAP for any changes or additions to the information previously submitted.
