Supreme Court to Hold Public Hearing on Proposed Court Rules

PROVIDENCE, RI - The Rhode Island Supreme Court will hold a public hearing in connection with its ongoing consideration of proposed amendments to multiple court rules that primarily relate to the Judiciary's transition from its current case access platform, the Rhode Island Judiciary Public Portal, to a new Tyler Technologies product, re:SearchRI. The technology's functionality could change remote public access to court documents.

On March 12, 2025, the Court issued proposed rules in anticipation of implementing re:SearchRI and invited written comment from the public, which were due on April 11, 2025. Following further internal review of the new public access platform, the proposed rules issued on March 12, 2025, have been modified and the Court is seeking additional public input by inviting interested parties to provide testimony at a public in-person hearing. The Supreme Court will hold the public hearing on **Wednesday, April 29, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.** in the Supreme Court courtroom.
