ORDER

This matter came before the Court in conference on the petition of Michael F. Kraemer (“petitioner”) seeking a determination from this Court that an inactive member of the bar not be required to maintain membership in the Rhode Island Bar Association (“Bar Association”).

It is hereby ordered that the petitioner and the Bar Association shall appear before this Court on a date and time to be determined by the Clerk to show cause why the petition should not be granted. The Bar Association may file a supplemental statement, not exceeding twenty (20) pages in length, within sixty (60) days of the issuance of this Order. Thereafter, the petitioner may file a supplemental statement, not exceeding twenty (20) pages in length, within ten (10) days of the filing of the Bar Association’s statement.

All other interested parties are invited to file supplemental statements as amici curiae addressing the petition. All supplemental statements of amici curiae shall not exceed twenty (20) pages in length and shall be filed within sixty (60) days of the date of this Order.
