Students and community groups gain direct access to and understanding of the third branch of government, the judiciary, through courthouse tours. Courthouse tours make the procedures, laws, issues, and officials of the justice system real for visitors of all ages. The 90-minute tour provides information about the Rhode Island Judiciary, the state court structure, and how the Supreme Court operates as the administrative court of the judiciary. Included in the tour are the public areas of the building such as a courtroom, conference room, rotunda, and the State Law Library. In-person walking tours are for sixteen (16) people or less, including a chaperone.
