

DIGEST OF ETHICS ADVISORY PANEL
OPINION #91-5, REQUEST #133
Issued February 20, 1991

An attorney seeks Panel advice as to whether an attorney may properly invite members of the judiciary to the opening ceremonies of the attorney's newly formed law office.

The Panel takes the position that there is no ethical problem presented by inviting members of the judiciary to the opening ceremonies of the attorney's newly formed law office.

Ethics Advisory Panel advice is protective in nature. There is no requirement that an attorney abide by a Panel opinion, but if he or she does, he or she is fully protected from any charge of impropriety.
