EXECUTIVE ORDER
Attorneys Attaining Age 70
Exempt from Continuing Legal Education Requirements
(Amending EO 2000-2 and EO 2004-02)

The purpose of this Order is to amend Executive Orders 2000-2 and 2004-02 relating to indigent counsel so as to clarify the continuing legal education obligations of senior attorneys assigned to the rotating lists or panels from which such counsel are selected by the courts. Pursuant to the authority vested in me by G. L. 1956 (1997 Reenactment) §8-15-2, it is hereby Ordered that notwithstanding any provision in the cited Executive Orders to the contrary, attorneys who have reached 70 years of age or more shall be exempt from the annual completion of continuing legal education prerequisites established in the cited Executive Orders as a condition for attorney recertification on the rotating lists or panels created by the respective courts.
